

KYG05 - Abandoned Mine Lands
Effective 6-1-09; Expired 5-31-14
(The 2014 draft permit renames this “Inactive Mine Lands”)
Currently not available for new coverage

This general permit authorizes existing discharges associated with abandoned pre-Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act (SMCRA) coal mined lands, abandoned mineral mined lands, and associated activities previously conducted in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

2014 Draft General Permit: KYG05 - Inactive Mine Lands
Public comment period closed 5-16-14

This draft general permit covers stormwater runoff from inactive mine lands on which natural resources were extracted and/or processed and which have not been reclaimed to applicable state or federal standards. It also covers the discharge of wastewaters from abandoned structures associated with such inactive mines. **As drafted, a Notice of Intent would be not required to be submitted and any facility to which this draft general permit is applicable would automatically be covered by this general permit when issued and effective.**
